SUNDAY SCHOOL COHORT CLASS OPTIONS – SPRING 2026

The Sunday School Cohort will begin the new quarter with a gathering in the fellowship hall at 9:45 a.m., where we will introduce the upcoming classes and teachers over coffee and donuts. I hope to see you that morning; however, if you are unable to attend, the following provides an overview of the options available for the next twelve-week rotation of courses. The three new class offerings are:

THE WAY OF WISDOM with Karla Hackworth

This class offers a thoughtful study of the Book of Proverbs. We will examine its major themes such as wisdom, discernment, speech, and the fear of the Lord. The goal is to apply these enduring principles to daily life to promote spiritual maturity and a deeper walk with the Lord.

CHASING RED LETTERS with Tim Dancy

As Bible students, we each understand that the information God has given us through His Holy Word is infinite and infallible. At times, we can find ourselves ‘chasing a rabbit’ while searching for the meaning of a complicated verse or passage. This can provide a fascinating journey that imparts a better understanding of Scripture, but we may struggle to identify its impact on our daily walk of obedience. In this class titled “Chasing the Red Letters”, we will analyze specific verses of direction spoken by our Savior in Luke’s Gospel. Our goal is to understand Christ’s meaning to those in His presence, to us as Christians today, and how His commands are hopefully taking shape in our faith journey.

PETER, PAUL and the HOLY SPIRIT with Dave Larson

Jesus came to earth as the Jewish Messiah; the fulfilment of prophecy to God’s chosen people, the Jews. Jesus came to establish a new covenant with the Jews, but when the Jews rejected Jesus and crucified Him on the cross, the opportunity for salvation was made available to us as Gentiles. As recorded in the Book of Acts, it was in an upper room during Pentecost when God sent his Holy Spirit to dwell within us, igniting the rapid spread of Christianity and the church. The Book of Acts is sometimes referred to as the Acts of the Apostles, but a more appropriate title might be the Acts of the Holy Spirit, for the spread of the gospel and establishment of churches throughout the Roman Empire and beyond cannot be explained without recognizing the power and guidance of the Holy Spirit. We see that especially in the missions of Peter and Paul. During the next 12 weeks we’ll be looking at the Trinity, the Holy Spirit, and the missions of both Peter and Paul.
